Volunteers need to be able to work independently.</p> <p>All volunteers must attend a New Volunteer Orientation (in person at Household Goods or via Zoom). After you attend orientation you will be able to sign-up for upcoming volunteer shifts (no volunteer drop-ins). A regular schedule is ideal, but you can schedule your shifts around sports or academic commitments. You can volunteer individually or organize your shifts to come in and volunteer together with friends.</p>
